

GROVE CITY SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING

FEBRUARY 26, 2014 @ 6:00PM

PRESENT: DRANGE, MILLER, PETERKA, CRAM

AGENDA:

A. RESOLUTION 2014-02 SALE OF REAL ESTATE. THE COUNCIL AGREED TO ACCEPT THE OFFER OF \$2500.00 FOR THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 105 AXEL AVE EAST WHICH IS OWNED BY THE CITY OF GROVE CITY. AFTER ALL OF THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE SALE WHICH TOTAL \$1427.39, THE CITY SHOULD RECEIVE A CHECK IN THE BALANCE OF \$1027.61 AND THE PROPERTY WILL BE BACK ON THE TAX ROLL. A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER PETERKA TO SELL THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 105 AXEL AVE FOR A PRICE OF \$2500.00. THE MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COUNCILMEMBER MILLER. MOTION CARRIED.

B. POLICY REGARDING DATA REQUESTS. THE CITY CLERK INFORMED THE COUNCIL THAT ANY AND ALL REQUESTS FOR PAPER COPIES OF DATA WILL BE AT A CHARGE OF 25 CENTS PER COPY. IF THE INFORMATION CAN BE REASONABLY RETRIEVED ELECTRONICALLY AND SENT TO THE REQUESTOR ELECTRONICALLY, THE CLERK CAN CHARGE THE REQUESTOR FOR THE TIME IT TAKES TO RETRIEVE SUCH INFORMATION AND ATTACH TO AN EMAIL. THE BILL FOR EITHER COPIES OR TIME WILL BE PAID BEFORE THE INFORMATION IS SENT.

ADJOURNMENT: A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER CRAM TO ADJOURN THE MEETING. THE MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COUNCILMEMBER PETERKA. MOTION CARRIED.

DAVE MARTIN SPOKE WITH THE COUNCIL ABOUT POSSIBLE FREEZING WATER LINES AND IT WAS DISCUSSED THAT THE CITY SHOULD FOLLOW OTHER CITIES IN GETTING WORD OUT TO ITS CUSTOMERS TO CHECK THE TEMPERATURE OF THEIR WATER AND RECOMMEND THAT THEY RUN THE WATER IF THE TEMPERATURE GOES BELOW 40 DEGREES. THE CUSTOMERS DO HOWEVER NEED TO CONTACT THE CITY OFFICE IF THEY ARE GOING TO BE RUNNING WATER AND THE ISSUE OF GIVING CREDITS FOR THE EXCESS OF WATER USED ABOVE THE NORMAL USAGE FOR MARCH WILL BE DISCUSSED AT THE NEXT COUNCIL MEETING.
