

GROVE CITY SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
APRIL 16, 2014 @ 6:30PM

AGENDA:

A. PROPOSAL ON LAUNDRY MAT: COUNCILMEMBER CRAM BROUGHT A PROPOSAL TO THE COUNCIL REGARDING THE SALE OF THE LAUNDRY MAT. THE COUNCIL DECIDED THAT THE OFFER WAS TOO LOW. COUNCILMEMBER NELSON MADE A MOTION TO MAKE A COUNTER OFFER AND SET A CLOSING DATE ON OR BEFORE MAY 30, 2014. THE MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COUNCILMEMBER PETERKA. MOTION CARRIED.

B. HIRING A PUBLIC WORKS SUPERINTENDENT: THE COUNCILMEMBERS DISCUSSED THE OTHER THREE CANDIDATES WHO HAD MADE IT INTO THE TOP FOUR OUT OF ALL OF THE INTERVIEWS. A MOTION WAS MADE TO HIRE CANDIDATE, DUSTIN GAARDER. THE MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COUNCILMEMBER NELSON. COUNCILMEMBERS CRAM, NELSON AND DRANGE VOTED YES. COUNCILMEMBERS MILLER AND PETERKA VOTED NO. MOTION CARRIED.

THERE WAS DISCUSSED ON THE STARTING WAGE: COUNCILMEMBER MILLER MADE A MOTION TO HIRE THE NEW PUBLIC WORKS SUPERINTENDENT AT A STARTING WAGE OF \$17.50 PER HOUR WITH A \$1.00 PER HOUR RAISE AFTER EACH OF THE LICENSES HAVE BEEN ACQUIRED. THE MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COUNCILMEMBER CRAM. MOTION CARRIED.
